Internationalisation of Higher Education A response to

- **Societal and technological changes worldwide**

Economic, demographic, environmental, technological, etc.

- **A growing demand for Higher Education**

From 100 million HE students in 2000 to 400 million in 2030

- **Increased competition in the Higher Education sector**

4 million international (/mobile) students today to 7 million by the end of the decade [EU receives +/- 50%; CN sends +/- 50%

- *Almost 30 years of ERASMUS*


EU HE cooperation worldwide

- Bilateral/regional support






Allocation over time




