#### **Relevant Ministries**

- Ministry of Civil Affairs BiH/Education Sector (national level, responsible for international cooperation and coordination)
- Federal Ministry of Education and Science/HE Sector (entity level, coordination between 10 cantons, no constitutional authority for HE policies)
- Ministry of Education and Culture RS (entity level, full authority for education)
- 10 Cantonal ministries of education (full authority for education)
- Government of Brcko District/Education Department (full authority for education)



### **Relevant Agencies in BiH**

- Agency for Development of Higher Education and Quality Assurance (HEA)
  - established in 2007 as an independent public organization;
  - sets criteria and standards for accreditation and selection of experts
  - provides recommendations on criteria and standards
- Higher Education Accreditation Agency of Republic of Srpska (RS HEAA)
  - established in 2011 as a public institution
  - organization and implementation of the external quality evaluation process
  - accreditation of HEIs and applied study programs
- Centre for Information and Recognition of Qualification in HE (CIP)
  - provide information/opinion on recognition of foreign degrees and diplomas



### **Relevant Legislation in BiH**

- Framework Law on Higher Education in BiH
  - adopted in 2007
  - establishes main principles in HE and responsibilities of authorities
  - sets methods of QA in HE
  - established two new agencies (HEA and CIP)
- Cantonal Laws on HE (all 10 cantons have laws on HE)
- Law on Higher Education in Republic of Srpska (RS)
  - adopted in July 2010
- Decision on Standards and Norms for HE in Federation of BIH
  - adopted in June 2008
- Strategic Document for Education Development and Implementation Plan for period 2008-2015
  - adopted in 2008 by Council of Ministers



#### **HE Institutions in BiH**

**51 licensed HEIs** in BiH (public and private), including:

- ➤ 10 public HEIs (8 universities and 2 colleges)
- ➤ 41 private HEIs (20 universities and 21 colleges)\*

(\*2 private universities and 2 colleges did not start with teaching process in this academic year)

- **3 decentralized public HEIs** (University of Sarajevo, Dzemal Bijedic University of Mostar and University of Mostar)
- **5 centralized public HEIs** (University of Zenica, University of Tuzla, University of Bihac, University of Banja Luka, University of East Sarajevo)
- **18 accredited HEIs** entered in the State Register of Accredited HEIs in Bosnia and Herzegovina, out of which there are 8 public and 10 private -14 universities and 4 colleges.
- **12 HEIs in the process of accreditation** in different phases, out of which all of them are private 7 universities and 5 colleges.

### **Programmes and Qualifications**

Under the *Framework Law*, HE in BiH is organized in the following 3 cycles:

- 1st cycle leading to an undergraduate Bachelor degree or equivalent
- can be obtained after 3 or 4 years of full-time study
- carries between 180 and 240 ECTS (with exceptions of studies in medical sciences, which can comprise up to 360 ECTS)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> cycle leading to a Master degree or equivalent
- lasts for 1 or 2 years
- can be obtained after completing undergraduate studies
- comprises between 60 and 120 ECTS
- the first two cycles together account for 300 ECTS
- 3rd cycle leading to a doctoral degree lasts 3 years and comprises 180 ECTS

Project title:	Determination of formula (the form) for the quantities of infiltra	tion of contaminated waters at landfills of municipal waste						
Project objective or type of cooperation:	The project aim is to get a form or a formula for determining the amount of those contaminated, infiltrated waters through landfill body in the terms of the rainfall amount, the size of evaporation, air humidity, air temperature, temperature in the body of the landfill as well as the compaction of waste material, and with the task of collection and drainage filtrate (contaminated infiltrated waters) and dimensioning of the drainage systems.  Field investigations would be carried out in four to five different landfills, from those sanitary regulated landfills (landfill Mošćanica near Zenica), on the landfill "Desetine" near Tuzla, municipal landfill in Gračanica, which is one of the unregulated landfills, then also an unregulated landfill in Banovići and landfill "Babunovići "near Srebrenik. The field investigations will last for one to two years. In the end, this project would resulted with a unique formula that could be used worldwide to determine the amount of the filtrate for dimensioning of the drainage system. I think this is a very interesting topic, because in the world there is no the form or formula for determining the quantities of of those contaminated, infiltrated waters through landfill body of the municipal waste.

BiH has been involved in Tempus programme since 1996

In period 1996-2013 implemented/under implementation:

- 153 Tempus projects (109 JP and 44 SM)
- 111 Individual Mobility Grants allocated supporting the mobility of teaching staff

Total value of these projects/grants was estimated at about 35 million EUR


