- *Law of Ukraine on Higher Education* (2014);
- Approved *List of Fields of Study and Subjects*;
- *Programme Areas* in line with *ISCED* (2015);
- *Guidelines for Higher Education Standards Development* based on ECTS, competences and learning outcomes, NQF (2016);
- Development of *Higher Education Standards* has started (2016)
- *National Qualification Framework* approved (2011);
- Approved regulation for *3rd cycle (PhD) higher education* (2015);
- *Quality Assurance: ESG* translated into Ukrainian (2015);
- Statute of *National Quality Assurance Agency* is developed and members selected (2016);
- *University autonomy*: regulations to wide finance autonomy (2015);
- Approved *Government regulations on academic (credit) mobility* (2015).



National Legislation for Erasmus+

It allows the Erasmus+ projects the following:

- to be visible as a cooperation project at the governmental levels;
- to inform and receive support from key beneficiary – Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine;
- to use the articles at all legislation regulations (e.g. Budget code, Tax code, national bank, public purchase law and others): the rules of the donor is used as subject of international agreement ratified by the Verkhovna Rada as a Law;
- the funds to be exempt from university income tax (20%);
- the funds to be exempt from obligatory selling of the 70% of currency;
- the goods (equipment etc.) and services to be VAT exempt;
- to use donors procedure and rules for tenders.




- HEIs capacity building to internationalize (mobility, joint/double/ multiple degree, foreign languages, management, finance etc.)





