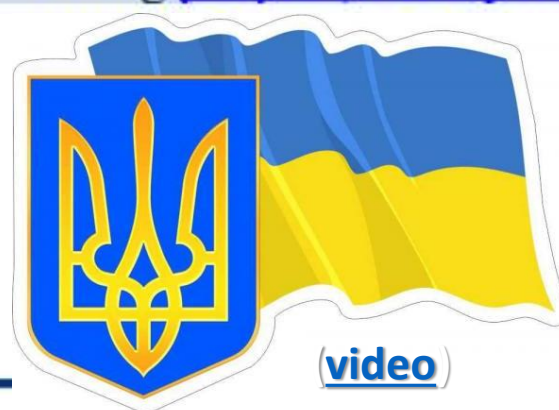

War in Ukraine

A new reality for the certificate of birth for a kid from Ukraine, if her parents are killed or this small Ukrainian girl died, kidnaped or get lost....



Day 62 (26.04.22)

- Ukraine suffers from the brutal, ruthless and large scale military aggression by russian federation.
- The aggressors troops are attacking Ukrainian cities, shooting civilians, kidnapping, bombarding kindergartens, schools, universities etc.
- 217 children are killed and more than 391 are injured
- 3818 civilians are killed, over 4000 are injured, 700thnds: forced to go to russia
- students, young people, academics and researchers are dying defending the values!!!
- 7.1 Million People Displaced by the War in Ukraine – 4.84 mln. abroad
- Out of 10.5 mln. young people: 2 mln. are internally displaced and 2 mln. are abroad!
- 1500 education institutions have suffered bombing and shelling, - and 102 of them have been destroyed completely

In spite of the war, the education started on 14 March in distance learning format!!!

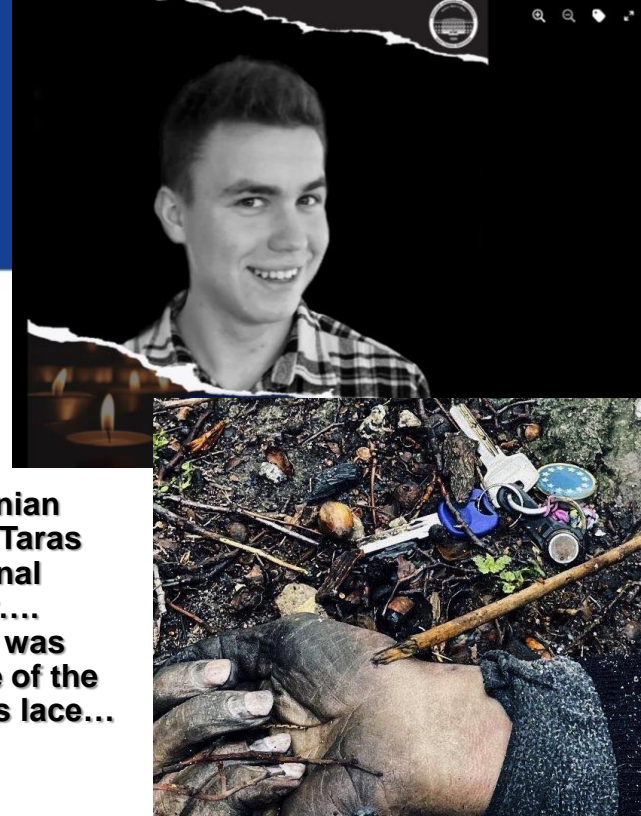
- The support in various fields is important: humanitarian, military, economic, education&research, equipment, infrastructure.
- More sanctions against the russian federation, including education sphere and academic cooperation: equal access and opportunities to the Programmes to respond the needs!
- Ukrainians are defending the identity and values strongly, protesting in front of tanks and guns in the cities under invasion vs russians benefiting form the opportunities abroad!!!
- 280 rectors of universities in the Russian Federation signed a letter in support of the russian aggression against Ukraine – majority of them have benefited and are still in partnerships of the EU's Programmes for education and youth since 1993!!!
- russians who behaved unhuman torturing Ukrainians, raping women and killed kids and civilians were educated in the period of Bologna process implementation in russia and active support of EU to russian universities, staff, students and young people (since 2005)!
- *EU funded Programmes impact on higher education and youth must be performed: investment into people2people contacts, quality of the European Studies on values!*

Crossing border by male students and staff during Martial Law is regulated by the Decree of the President of Ukraine of 24.02.2022 № 64/2022 «On the imposition of martial law in Ukraine» prohibits male Ukrainian citizens aged 18 to 60 from travelling abroad.

The Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine Regulation № 264 dated as of 12/03/2022 (<https://zakon.rada.gov.ua/laws/show/264-2022-%D0%BF#Text>) regulated exceptions which include among other things: “... students for higher education, graduate students and doctoral students studying abroad in full-time or dual forms of education (students, learners); people with disabilities and accompanying persons...”

KA131 Staff/student mobility in HE	<p><u>Eligibility rules for participants coming from Ukraine</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> For students: being enrolled in a Higher Education institution (HEI) at the moment of fleeing Ukraine due to the Russian aggression. For recent graduates: having graduated from a HEI in Ukraine within maximum 12 months before the moment of fleeing Ukraine due to the Russian aggression. For staff: being employed in a HEI in Ukraine at the moment of fleeing Ukraine due to the Russian aggression. <p><u>Eligible activities</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The activities have to take place at the beneficiary HEI. In cases when, due to the war, the sending organisation cannot be involved in the activity, the beneficiary HEI is the only HEI involved in the organisation of the mobility, except for traineeships outside of the HEI. For students: mobility for studies and mobility for traineeships. For traineeships this also includes traineeships for recent graduates (the term students will include them in these special provisions. In these cases, the beneficiary institution has to arrange the traineeships. The trainees are hosted either at the beneficiary HEI or, in a non-HEI organisation in the same country (using the KA107 learning agreement for incoming trainees). In the latter case, the traineeship mobility is to be funded by the beneficiary HEI. For staff: mobility for teaching (including invited staff from non-HEI organisations) and mobility for training. <p><u>Application</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Participants apply directly to the beneficiary HEI in or through which they would like to undertake a mobility. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> There is no need for an inter-institutional agreement. There is no need for nominations The learning agreement/staff mobility agreement is signed only between the participant and the receiving institution (plus with the traineeship hosting organisation if it is not the HEI). The beneficiary/receiving HEI can allow enrolment on a rolling basis with no nomination deadline

3 LEGAL FRAMEWORK

Law on Education, Law on Higher Education, Law on Vocational Education, Law on Secondary Education and other regulations are underpinned by a democratic and pro-European agenda

4 INSTITUTIONAL AUTONOMY AND ACADEMIC MOBILITY

HEIs define admission requirements, contents of education programs, fulfill foreign degrees recognition, issue documents on education

HEIs obtain gradually more financial autonomy and self-governance.

5 GENERAL SECONDARY EDUCATION AND ACCESS TO HIGHER EDUCATION

General secondary education is under the reform to implement 12 year program (till 2030) to replace 11 year program. Access to HE is based on the Certificate of Complete General Secondary Education and according to the results of External Independent Evaluation (EIE)

6 UNIFIED STATE ELECTRONIC DATABASE ON EDUCATION

USEDE provides the registers of Ukrainian HEIs, issued educational documents, EIE results, accreditation decisions and other related data on education

7 NATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS FRAMEWORK
