International Outlook

- ❑ **47%** of master's and doctoral students are international
- ❑ **25%** of the teaching staff is international
- ❑ **32** degree programs taught in English
- ❑ International alliances: **EUTOPIA**
- ❑ **International agreements** (+ 390) - 28 of the Top 50 universities in the world (*THE ranking, 2022*)
- ❑ **1st** Spanish university in international Outlook (*THE ranking, 2023*)

How to apply to a master degree program at UPF?

Online from November to June

- ❑ **Official university bachelor's or master's degree** from the European Higher Education Area (EHEA) or equivalent foreign degree allowing access to a postgraduate degree in the country that issued the degree.
- ❑ Each programme is subject to specific admission requirements. Before starting your application please check the admission requirements and application documents.
- ❑ Candidates who have graduated from a university of a non-EU country must legalize their documents in their country of origin before the [enrolment](#) in September.



How to apply to a doctoral program?

Online from November to June

- ❑ **Official university bachelor's and master's degree** from the European Higher Education Area (EHEA) or equivalent foreign degree allowing access to a postgraduate degree in the country that issued the degree.
- ❑ To access a PhD programme at UPF you must have an official university degree and a master's degree, and have passed at least 300 ECTS credits.
- ❑ Thesis proposal – department lines of research
- ❑ Meet specific requirements
- ❑ Candidates who have graduated from a university of a non-EU country must legalize their documents in their country of origin before the [enrolment](#) in September.



Other study options

- ❑ Visiting students
- ❑ Barcelona International Summer School (BISS) – July
- ❑ Barcelona Program for Interdisciplinary Studies (BaPIS) – Autumn (September to December) and winter (January to March)
- ❑ Language program: Spanish Programme
