Profile of participants:

Headmasters and teachers of upper secondary schools interested in the realization of projects in the framework of Erasmus+ programme (key action 2).

Themes and goals of the event:

Schools submitting applications to Erasmus+ often present low awareness when preparing coherent proposals in terms of needs analysis, formulation of goals, actions, results, dissemination and sustainability and the adequacy to Erasmus+ priorities. Responding to this diagnosis, a goal of the event is to support teachers and headmasters in the professionalization of the knowledge and skills necessary for the planning and realization of educational international cooperation projects. Some areas that will be tackled are inner logic of the project; quality of partnership; learning, teaching, training activities; dissemination and sustainability of project results.

Training is prepared in cooperation with 5 NAs and will be supported by trainers, which are experts in planning and realizing international projects. Participants will work in teams on the draft of projects concerning their interest, so groups will have possibility to choose themes of projects important from the point of view of their institutions and local communities.

Expected results:

Participants will broaden their knowledge and skills concerning project planning and management. Participants will find partners for projects and will create drafts of projects.

Cost:

Event fee: The event fee will be covered by the hosting agency and it will include accommodation (4 nights) and meals during the activity.
