Training in a Finnish context”**

Profile of participants: principals, headteachers, vice-principals, inspectors, those in school leadership and representatives of education and training authorities.

Themes and goals of the event: The aim of the visit is to give the participants a general view of Finnish general education, teacher training and information on Finnish school leadership and development.

The themes will cover learning environments, principles of the new curriculum, student assessment, school subjects, the role of school leaders in a change, Finnish teacher training schools and their role in teacher training and possibilities for the internationalisation of schools.

Participants will:

- have lectures, workshops, discussions
- a visit to the Koli National Park and a walking and talking trail – peer-learning and possibilities for internationalization and networking
- school visits and some observations
- meet local principals, teachers and teacher trainers as well as students
- have an introduction to the activities of the Erasmus+ programme

Cost:

Meals and accommodation: Meals and accommodation during the Seminar will be covered by the hosting NA agency and it will cover accommodation and meals during the seminar (4 nights).

Travel costs: SEPIE will contribute to the travel costs based on the table provided for TCAs. This financial support will be paid directly to the selected participant by SEPIE in compliance with the procedures established by this agency (see information on the SEPIE website).

Support for accommodation and meals not included in the activity programme: SEPIE will contribute to these costs based on the table provided for TCAs. This financial support (up to 2 travel days) will be paid directly to the selected participant by SEPIE in compliance with the procedures established by this agency (see information on the SEPIE website).

Support for participants with special needs: Applicants with special needs might apply for a reimbursement based on real costs. The reimbursement based on real costs will be granted only if it is clearly justified and requested in the application form, and once approved by the national agency (SEPIE). This financial support will be paid directly to the selected participant by SEPIE in compliance with the procedures established by this agency (see information on the SEPIE website). By choosing this option, the participant will renounce to a reimbursement based on unit costs.
